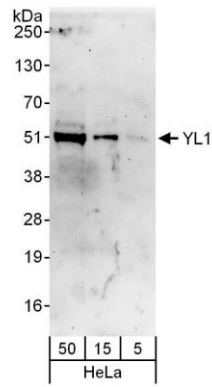

<b>SPECIES REACTIVITY</b>	Human
<b>PRESUMED REACTIVITY</b>	Based on 100% sequence identity, this antibody is predicted to react with Mouse, Bovine and Orangutan
<b>AMOUNT</b>	100 µl (10 blots)

<b>PRODUCTION PROCEDURES</b>	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to YL1 immobilized on solid support.  The epitope recognized by A303-115A-M maps to a region between residue 50 and 100 of human Protein YL-1 using the numbering given in entry NP_005988.1 (GeneID 6944).
<b>APPLICATIONS</b>	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.  Western Blot 1:1000  Immunoprecipitation The antibody contained within A303-115A-M has been qualified for use in immunoprecipitation; however, we recommend using the alternative formulation of this antibody found as product A303-115A.
<b>APPLICATION NOTES</b>	Western blot of immunoprecipitates performed using Normal Pig Serum (Cat. No. S100-020), Goat anti-Rabbit Light Chain HRP Conjugate (Cat. No. A120-113P) and 4-20% SDS-PAGE (link to IP-western blot protocol in Additional Info section below).  Western blot of lysates performed using standard western blot reagents and 4-20% SDS-PAGE.

**Detection of human YL1 by western blot.** *Samples:* Whole cell lysate (5, 15, and 50 µg) from HeLa cells. *Antibody:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-YL1 antibody A303-115A-M used at 1:1000. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 3 minutes.
